Colleges and universities will hold Peace Day observances throughout the day, and in some cities throughout the whole week of Sept. 19. YOU, your friends and your classmates are invited to participate in this global day of local opportunity!

Peace Day activities are flexible and can connect with multiple curriculum areas, as well as the programming of clubs, campus groups, sororities and fraternities.

Peace Day activities can involve education, the arts, writing, discussion, intercultural activities, community service, sports, environmental projects and so much more. **Activity examples:** *Create collaborative peace art projects - Clean up trash in your community or enhance a campus recycling program - Organize an intercultural program - Do a service project or fundraiser for a good cause - Meditate - Learn about a human rights issue in the world - Host a “Feast for Peace” with foods from different cultures - join the world by observing a minute of silence for peace at 12 noon (a global activity in all timezones)...*
