Villanova University is located at 800 E. Lancaster Avenue (Route 30) in Villanova.

From the west turn left onto Ithan Avenue, proceed about 500 feet and turn left again to enter the campus at the security gate. Let the public safety officers know you are attending the CommUNITY Breakfast. They will be expecting you.

Drive straight about 1000 feet. The Connelly Center (#9 on map) is on your left and the St. Augustine Center for the Liberal Arts Parking Garage (#46 on map) is on your right. Please park in garage and walk over to the Connelly Center.

The Villanova Room is on the ground floor of the Connelly Center. Please look for the registration table and proceed there to collect your name tag from the steering committee volunteers.

Please allow yourself ample time to drive over safely and to park and walk over to the Connelly Center as we start promptly at 7:30 a.m.
