The observance of One Minute of Silence/A Moment of Peace will be rolled out to schools and tertiary education institutions, and other sectors of the community. We will have a short performance to finish the ceremony in the morning and followed with an afternoon variety performance featuring ethnic songs and dances, champion magician performing his famous 'dove magic' show , African Drum Dance and workshop to name a few, plus a host of artists and the multi award winning concert pianist Colleen Lee, Peace Music Ambassador of the Foundation to kick off the week long Hong Kong Peace Festival 2012.

In union with the theme of 'Sustainable Peace for a Sustainable Future,' as declared by the United Nations for UN Peace Day this year, a 3-day Youth Conference based on the Peace Day theme, will be held from September 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> in association with Maryknoll Convent School on Kowloon side, a famous heritage site. Notable speakers from Hong Kong and the region are invited to speak at the Peace Education, Green and Interfaith Conference. We aim at leveraging this platform and dialogue to facilitate exchange and understanding among different faith, ethnic, business concerns groups in Hong Kong to help achieve a long term sustainable future. The Conference will be the basis of the 'East meets West' programme connecting young people from different parts of the world.

Music is a great way to achieve inner peace, this year PIF is excited to bring globally renowned performers from Hong Kong and Costa Rica together to play a wide range of East meets West repertoire featuring Dan Yu, 1<sup>st</sup> prize winner at 5<sup>th</sup> USA International Harp Competition; Dr. Derek Anthony, Asia's leading operatic bass and vocal coach and first prize winner of 5 vocal competitions; Colleen Lee – PIF Peace Music Ambassador, winner of 6<sup>th</sup> Prize at prestigious International Frederic Chopin Piano Competition, Warsaw, featured artist at international music festivals and global performer; Esteban Alvarez - Native of Costa Rica, Steinway Resident Artist, composer and concert pianist, special award winner for song composition at National Peace Program of Costa Rica, and the Organization of Costa Rica & Nicaragua and Shirley Lo - Music Director, prize winner of Japan-Hong Kong International Music Competition 2012, regional concert pianist, and gives special performance at the annual UN International Day of Peace Ceremony.

To end the week-long Peace Festival, a Closing Ceremony will be held after the Peace Day Green Concert, followed by a celebration reception.

At a later date, a Road Show exhibition of photography from artists who captured the precious moments of the Festival to be shared by the community – as a reminder of peace.
