Here are some suggestions for community peace activities, though you are encouraged to create your own that reflect the vision and hopes of your community! ! Activities, in person and on-line, can take place September 15 - September 21 (Peace Day itself).

- * Gather together community members, leaders, police and youth for a peace & unity march or activity.
- * Write an Op-Ed about the challenges to peace in your community and paths to greater peace
- * Organize an on-line or in person peace vigil or interfaith dialogue.
- * Host an on-line discussion about police/community relations.
